**Pre-Departure Information Package**  
**September 2018**

We are looking forward to welcoming you to Vernon and teaching you about living in Canada. You will become an important part of our International Program “family”. Here is what we are working on right now:

- We are placing all of our new students in schools to create a community of international students. You can look forward to meeting students from Canada and many countries from all over the world!
- Our teachers and counselors in the schools are planning your class schedule to find a great combination of courses for your studies. Your courses will be chosen based on your application and your program.
- We are also reviewing your homestay profile to find the best homestay family match we can. All students will receive information about their new Canadian family at least one month before arrival.

**When to Arrive in Canada**

You should book your flight to **arrive between Monday, August 27 and Sunday, September 2, 2018**. Flights should be booked to arrive and depart to/from **Kelowna International Airport (YLW)**. There will be additional costs of \$40.00 per day for students who arrive prior to August 27, 2018. You should not arrive earlier unless you have registered for the English Preparation program which runs from August 27 to August 31, 2018.

Please remember that you will now need an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) to fly to or transit through Canada. To avoid delays, it is best to apply for an eTA before booking your flight. For more information, and to apply for an eTA, please visit [Canada.ca/eTA](http://Canada.ca/eTA).

Once you have booked your flight, please inform the International Student Program office and provide them with a copy of your travel itinerary – send to [admissions@sd22.bc.ca](mailto:admissions@sd22.bc.ca). We will ensure that your host family is available to meet you at the Kelowna International Airport.

**Connect with your Host Family**

You will be provided with the profile and contact information for your host family in Canada at least **one month before your arrival**. Once you receive this information, contact the family and start getting to know each other. Ask questions, share information and get comfortable with your new host family. This is a chance to find out anything that will make your stay in Canada more comfortable.

**Student Orientation – Thursday, August 30, 2018**

Orientation will include valuable information for your successful transition to your new school and life in Canada. We will discuss topics such as academic programs and expectations, course registration and school activities. You will meet the staff, other students, ask lots of questions, and have fun!
